**UPDATE AND CHANGE IN THE USE OF PROCEEDS FROM SHARE PLACEMENT AND
WARRANTS ISSUE**

The Board of Directors (the “Board” or the “Directors”) of Eneco Energy Limited (the “Company”, and together with its subsidiaries, the “Group”) refers to the Company’s announcements on 25 March 2022, 14 July 2022, 1 August 2022 and 2 September 2022 (collectively, the “Placement Announcements”) as well as the circular to shareholders dated 4 August 2022 (the “Circular”) in relation to, *inter alia*, the Shares Placement cum Warrants Issue (the “Placement Exercise”). - Update and Change in the Use of Proceeds from Share Placement and Warrants Issue

The Company re-allocated S\$2.0 million of the net proceeds from “growth, development and expansion” to “working capital needs”. The re-allocated funds would be used to support the Group’s general corporate expenses including staff expenses, professional and consultancy charges, trade creditors payments and other overhead expenses.

The Company will continue to maintain a healthy cash reserve that would enable it to secure alternative revenue and profit streams from new investments and open up new markets that will contribute towards increasing profitability and shareholders’ value.
